

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate \$300,000.00 of the dividends collected by the Commonwealth Economic Development Authority (CEDA) from the Commonwealth Utilities Corporation (CUC) to fund Super Typhoon Sinlaku disaster relief operations and personnel projects in the First Senatorial District; and for other purposes.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE 24TH NORTHERN MARIANAS
COMMONWEALTH LEGISLATURE:**

1 **Section 1. Findings and Purpose.** The Legislature finds that the First
2 Senatorial District requires additional funding to ~~improve and maintain projects to~~
3 respond to Super Typhoon Sinlaku disaster relief operations and personnel in the
4 First Senatorial District.

5 Therefore, the purpose of this Act is to appropriate dividends collected by the
6 Commonwealth Economic Development Authority (CEDA) from the
7 Commonwealth Utilities Corporation (CUC) to fund ~~projects~~ for the typhoon
8 disaster relief operations and personnel within the First Senatorial District.

9 **Section 2. Appropriation and Project Approval.** “Notwithstanding any
10 provision(s) of law, statutes, rules, or regulations to the contrary and pursuant to 4
11 CMC § 10508, the \$300,000.00 of the dividends collected by CEDA from CUC for

1 ~~projects in the First Senatorial District. The Rota Legislative Delegation shall adopt~~
2 ~~a resolution to distribute funds for projects in the municipality is appropriated as~~
3 ~~follows:~~

4 ~~(a) Out of the \$300,000.00, \$200,000.00 shall be used to fund Super Typhoon~~
5 ~~disaster relief operations and personnel in the First Senatorial District, and~~
6 ~~\$100,000.00 is reserved for personnel and operations for the Office of the~~
7 ~~Mayor of Rota, in accordance with an adopted resolution by the Rota~~
8 ~~Legislative Delegation.”~~

9 **Section 3. No Fiscal Year Limitation.** The funds appropriated under this
10 Act shall be without fiscal year limitation.

11 **Section 4. Expenditure Authority.** The expenditure authority of the funds
12 in a portion under this Act, Section 2, shall be the Mayor of the Municipality of
13 Rota.

14 **Section 5. Fund Transfer.**

15 The \$300,000.00 appropriated under Section 2 shall be transferred within a
16 reasonable time by the Commonwealth Economic Development Authority to the
17 Rota Municipal Treasury upon this Act becoming law.

18 **Section 6. Reporting Requirement.** The Mayor of Rota shall provide a
19 monthly expenditure report of the funds appropriated in a portion of Section 2 to
20 the Chairperson of the Rota Legislative Delegation.

1 **Section 7. Reprogramming.** The funds appropriated in a portion under
2 Section 2 shall not be reprogrammed unless approved by resolution by the Rota
3 Legislative Delegation.

4 **Section 5 8. Severability.** If any provisions of this Act or the application of
5 any such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court
6 of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its
7 provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid
8 shall not be affected thereby.

9 **Section 6 9. Savings Clause.** This Act and any repealer contained herein shall
10 not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired
11 under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation, or order adopted under the
12 statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted
13 under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect
14 of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall
15 already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

16 **Section 7 10. Effective Date.** This Act shall take effect upon its approval by
17 the Governor, or it becoming law without such approval.
