**A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT
FOR THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT**

To re-appropriate funds under Section 2(t)(d) of Saipan Local Law 23-04 (Project Code 7190M); and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION

PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE

COMMONWEALTH CODE:

1 **SECTION 1. PURPOSE.**

2 The purpose of this Act is to re-appropriate \$60,000.00 from funds under
3 Section 2(t)(d) of Saipan Local Law 23-04 (Project Code 7190M).

4 **SECTION 2. RE-APPROPRIATION.**

5 Notwithstanding any provision(s) of law, statutes, rules or regulations to the
6 contrary and pursuant to funds allocated to the Third Senatorial District the Saipan
7 and Northern Islands Legislative Delegation (SNILD) hereby re-appropriates
8 \$60,000.00 from funds under Section 2(t)(d) of Saipan Local Law 23-04 (Project
9 Code 7190M) as follows:

- 10 a) Thirty-five Thousand dollars (\$35,000.00) to the Natibu Sports
11 Association (NSA) for the repair and improvement of the Capitol Hill

1 Softball Field Dugouts and for operations to conduct and facilitate youth
2 sports programs and activities in Precinct IV.

3 b) Ten Thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) to the Talabwogh Stars
4 Association's operations to conduct and facilitate youth programs and
5 activities in Precinct IV.

6 c) Fifteen Thousand dollars (\$15,000.00) to the Marianas Surf Skate
7 League to conduct skate and surfing events and to make improvements
8 in skate parks.

9 **SECTION 3. EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY.**

10 1) The expenditure authority for the funds under Section 2(a) shall be
11 the President of the NSA.

12 2) The expenditure authority for the funds under Section 2(b) shall be
13 the President/Chairperson of the Talabwogh Stars Association.

14 3) The expenditure authority for the funds under Section 2(c) shall be
15 the Chairperson of the Marianas Surf Skate League.

16 **SECTION 4. REPROGRAMMING.**

17 Notwithstanding any laws, provisions, or regulations to the contrary, funds
18 appropriated under this act shall not be reprogrammed for any other purpose.

19 **SECTION 5. FISCAL YEAR.**

20 The funds allocated under this Act shall be without fiscal year limitation(s).

21 **SECTION 6. REPORTING OF EXPENDITURES.**

1 Expenditures of the funds allocated under Section 2 of this Act shall be
2 responsible to report all expenses to the Chairperson of the Saipan and Northern
3 Islands Legislative Delegation a detail report showing the expenditure of the funds.
4 Provided further that failure to provide all expenses, entities that were afforded
5 funds under this Act shall not be able to avail to any future funds appropriated by
6 the Saipan and Northern Islands Legislative Delegation.

7 **SECTION 7. FUND DISTRIBUTION.**

8 Funds appropriated under Section 2 of this Act shall be distributed
9 accordingly to the intended purpose and or entity upon this Act becoming law.

10 **SECTION 8. SEVERABILITY.**

11 If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any
12 person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction,
13 the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or
14 circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected
15 thereby.

16 **SECTION 9. SAVINGS CLAUSE.**

17 This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as
18 affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes
19 repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes.
20 Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or
21 pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of

1 terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall
2 already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.


3 **SECTION 10. EFFECTIVE DATE.**


4 This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or its becoming
