**A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT
FOR THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT**

To re-appropriate the remaining fund balance of \$221,649.00 under Saipan Local Law 22-16 (Project Code 2001E); and for other purposes.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT TO
CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:**

1 SECTION 1. PURPOSE.

2 The purpose of this Act is to re-appropriate the remaining fund balance of \$221,649.00
3 under Saipan Local Law 22-16 (Project Code 2001E) for the construction, renovation, and/or
4 repair of speed bumps, bus shelters, restroom facilities, crosswalks, installation of street lights and
5 traffic signages, and road repairs/improvements within Precinct V, and for other purposes.

6 SECTION 2. RE-APPROPRIATION.

7 Notwithstanding any provisions, statutes, laws, or regulations to the contrary, the Saipan
8 and Northern Islands Legislative Delegation hereby re-appropriates the remaining fund balance of
9 \$221,649.00, which shall be allocated as follows:

10 (a) \$221,649.00 allotted under Saipan Local Law 22-16, specifically under Project Code 2001E,

1 for the construction, renovation, and/or repair of speed bumps, bus shelters, restroom facilities,
2 crosswalks, installation of street lights and traffic signages, and road repairs/improvements
3 within Precinct V.

4 **SECTION 3. EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY.**

5 The expenditure authority for the funds under Section 2 (d) of this Act shall be the
6 Secretary of the Department of Public Works.

7 **SECTION 4. REPROGRAMMING.**

8 Notwithstanding any laws, provisions or regulations to the contrary, funds appropriated
9 under this Act shall not be reprogrammed for any other purpose.

10 **SECTION 5. REPORTING.**

11 The expenditure authority shall submit to the Chairperson of the Saipan and Northern
12 Islands Legislative Delegation a detail report showing the expenditure of the funds at the
13 completion of appropriations in Section 2 of this Act.

14 **SECTION 6. FUND DISTRIBUTION.**

15 Funds appropriated under Section 2 of this Act shall be distributed accordingly to the
16 intended purpose and or entity upon this Act becoming law.

17 **SECTION 7. FISCAL YEAR.**

18 The funds allocated under this Act shall be without fiscal year limitation(s).

19 **SECTION 8. SEVERABILITY.**

20 If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or
21 circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act
22 or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held

1 invalid shall not be affected thereby.

2 **SECTION 9. SAVINGS CLAUSE.**

3 This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing
4 right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation or
5 order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding
6 instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of
7 terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in
8 existence on the date this Act becomes effective.


9 **SECTION 10. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

10 This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or it becoming law without
11 such approval.
