## NINETEENTH COMMONWEALTH OF THE NORTHERN MARIANA ISLANDS YOUTH CONGRESS

RD REGULAR Session, 2023 Y.C. Res. No. 19-05

## A YOUTH CONGRESS RESOLUTION

Relative to recognizing the delegates of the Diocese of Chalan Kanoa to the 2023 World Youth Day, held from Aug. 1-6, 2023, in Lisbon, Portugal

1	WHEREAS, on July 24, 2023, 40 delegates from the Diocese of Chalan	
2	Kanoa started their three-week long journey to ultimately celebrate mass with Pope	
3	Francis, the head of the Roman Catholic Church, during the 2023 World Youth Day	
4	(WYD) hosted in Lisbon, Portugal; and	
5	WHEREAS, the World Youth Day event is a Catholic celebration in which	
6	pilgrims from all over the world are able to profess and deepen their faith, address	
7	universal issues that affect the Roman Catholic Church, and celebrate mass with	
8	the most holy father, Pope Francis; and	
9	WHEREAS, parishes all over the Commonwealth had diverse and unique	
10	ways of providing the essential funds necessary to make this mission possible,	
11	examples include golf tournaments, family fun days, bake sales, car washes,	
12	producing donation boxes, while other parishes took a different approach by	
13	fundraising through pledges; and	

1 WHEREAS, with months of discipline and diligence, the delegates 2 successfully traveled to Portugal where they exposed themselves to once in a 3 lifetime experiences; and 4 WHEREAS, prior to the main World Youth Day events, representatives of the Diocese of Chalan Kanoa participated in the Days in the Diocese hosted by the 5 6 Diocese of Algarve in Tavira, Portugal; and 7 WHEREAS, in the Days in the Diocese, parishes from all around the world 8 were able to gather together as young people from July 24-31, 2023, before the 9 2023 World Youth Day that took place the following week; and 10 WHEREAS, on August 1, 2023, the representatives of the Diocese of 11 Chalan Kanoa took on a more rigorous journey as they ventured into the World 12 Youth Day celebration; and 13 WHEREAS, the delegates were housed in a school gym in Lisbon that 14 accommodated over 50 pilgrims and had only two available shower rooms and also 15 walked by foot to their destination when public transportation was not accessible; 16 and 17 WHEREAS, the delegates endured numerous environments that refused to emphasize the commodities of the modern world, to mimic a sense of what life was 18 19 like for pilgrims hundreds of years ago during the times of Christ; and 20 WHEREAS, despite the discomfort and hardships experienced, the 21 delegates were able to lead group conversations of over 100 youth pilgrims, lead 22 Eucharistic Celebrations at historic catholic venues, and spread the positivity and

1 beauty of the CNMI which revealed their sheer leadership, perseverance and 2 compassion; and NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Nineteenth 3 Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands Youth Congress, that the Youth 4 5 Congress recognize the pilgrims from the Diocese of Chalan Kanoa for their hard 6 work and perseverance prior and during the 2023 World Youth Day and for 7 representing the CNMI at the biggest Catholic function in the world; and 8 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Sponsor of this Resolution or the 9 designee of the Speaker of the Youth Congress shall present a certified original 10 copy of this Youth Congress Resolution to the Most Reverend Ryan P. Jimenez, 11 Bishop of the Diocese of Chalan Kanoa; and 12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Speaker of the Youth Congress 13 shall certify, and the Youth Congress Legislative Secretary shall attest to the 14 adoption of this resolution and thereafter shall transmit a certified copy to the Honorable Edmund S. Villagomez, Speaker of the House of Representatives (23rd 15 16 Northern Marianas Commonwealth Legislature); the Honorable Edith E. DeLeon 17 Guerrero, President of the Senate (23rd Northern Marianas Commonwealth 18 Legislature); the Honorable Arnold I. Palacios, Governor of the Commonwealth of 19 the Northern Mariana Islands; the Honorable Gregorio Kilili Camacho Sablan, CNMI Delegate to the House of Representatives (118th United States Congress). 20
