A YOUTH CONGRESS RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Marianas Performing Arts Competition Corporation (MPACC) is a nonprofit organization that was established to showcase the musically talented local artists of the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands (CNMI) with a mission to showcase the three winners of the first ever Marianas Got Talent to compete and represent the CNMI on a national scale through their participation in renowned and televised singing competitions, such as: American Idol, America's Got Talent, and The Voice; and WHEREAS, MPACC recently held the first Marianas Got Talent through a series of elimination rounds which concluded in November of 2023 with the top three winners: Bernice Shane Sabino, in third; Donato Santiago, in second; and Sebastian Lifoifoi Tajibmai, Jr., in first; and WHEREAS, Sebastian Lifoifoi Tajibmai, Jr. was born on June 12, 2006 on the beautiful island of Saipan and is the proud son of Sebastian and Josephine Lifoifoi Tajibmai; and WHEREAS, Sebastian Lifoifoi Tajibmai, Jr. is a humble son from the north side of Saipan where he was raised in a tight-knit, village community and instilled with the fundamental values of family, respect, and a deep appreciation for songs

and genres that have been passed from generation to generation; and

1 WHEREAS, Sebastian Lifoifoi Tajibmai, Jr. is well-known for his soulful 2 vocals, humble spirit, incorporating personal twists to covers of familiar songs, and 3 composing original lyrics that touch the hearts of his listeners; and 4 WHEREAS, Sebastian Lifoifoi Tajibmai, Jr. finds contentment and joy in 5 entertaining the community on stage alongside his brothers in their group known as 6 Nesian Harmony, showcasing their talent at locally held music events, such as 7 Boogie Down at Obyan Competition and multiple student-led clubs of Kagman 8 High School sharing their talent and passion for music; and 9 WHEREAS, through the support of his family and friends, Sebastian 10 Lifoifoi Tajibmai, Jr. acquired the self-confidence to stand onstage and perform 11 before a panel of judges during the first ever Marianas Got Talent competition held 12 on Saipan; and 13 WHEREAS, through his love for music, unique interpretation of the chords 14 and originally composed songs, Sebastian Lifoifoi Tajibmai, Jr. impressed the 15 judges, which garnered him first place in the 2023 Marianas Got Talent competition 16 and will humbly represent the CNMI on nationally televised singing competitions 17 in the coming months; and 18 WHEREAS, as a young, local musician in his prime, Sebastian Lifoifoi 19 Tajibmai, Jr. continues to inspire young artists of the CNMI to showcase their 20 talent, unite our community through song, and to be part of the journey in 21 navigating the vocal talents of our people to be heard beyond the serene shores of 22 the Marianas; and 23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Nineteenth 24 Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands Youth Congress, that the Youth 25 Congress hereby recognizes and congratulates Sebastian Lifoifoi Tajibmai, Jr. of 26 Kagman High School for his outstanding performance and amazing talent 27 showcased in the 2023 Marianas Got Talent; and
