## A YOUTH CONGRESS RESOLUTION

Commending Ms. Alleena Villaluz of Saipan International School on winning the title of the 2024 Scripps Regional Spelling Bee for the Pacific Region.

2	the Marianas to continue studying and striving for higher education and
3	opportunities; and
4	WHEREAS, the Scripps Regional Spelling Bee held by the Rotary Club of
5	Guam offers the chance to students across the Pacific to showcase their abilities to
6	spell and knowledge of words; and
7	WHEREAS, a total of 69 students enrolled in the Bee, and 60 students
8	competed on March 3, 2024; and
9	WHEREAS, the winner of the Scripps Regional Spelling Bee for the
10	Pacific will represent the region at the national spelling bee in Washington, D.C.,
11	in May; and
12	WHEREAS, Alleena Villaluz outspelled 59 elementary and middle school
13	students from Guam, the Northern Mariana Islands, and the Federated States of
14	Micronesia; and
15	WHEREAS, Alleena Villaluz competed in 15 rounds before winning the
16	2024 Regional Bee; and
17	WHEREAS, Alleena Villaluz correctly spelled the words 'sieve' and
18	'benignant' to clench the title to the 2024 Scripps Regional Spelling Bee; and

1	WHEREAS, in addition to her title, Alleena Villaluz received the Samuel
2	Louis Sugarman Award provided by Jay Sugarman, chairman and CEO of iStar
3	Financial; and
4	WHEREAS, Alleena Villaluz's achievement brings tremendous honor to
5	herself, Saipan International School, and the entire CNMI; and
6	WHEREAS, this rare achievement for a student of the CNMI encourages
7	and inspires all academics to persevere in their studies and participate in
8	extracurriculars; and
9	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Nineteenth
10	Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands Youth Congress, that the Youth
